Day Trip to Kings Canyon

Kings Canyon National Park Visitors Center

1.5 Hours

After entering the park, continue on Hwy-180 until you reach the Kings Canyon Visitor Center. This visitor center is a great first stop on your journey through Kings Canyon and features information about the park, as well as a gift shop. Also, the visitor center is adjacent to one of the most famous trees in the world, the General Grant Tree, known as the nation's Christmas tree.

Boyden Cavern

2.5 Hours

Continuing down Hwy-180 you will be awed by the majestic views of Kings Canyon and the High Sierra. Once you reach the bottom of the canyon, you will come across one of the highlights of the park, Boyden Cavern. Hour long guided tours of the cavern are available 10am-5pm on the hour. The knowledgeable guide will inform you about the many beautiful rock formations in the cavern, as well as the history of its discovery.

Cedar Grove

1.5 Hours

Next, continue down Hwy-180 towards Cedar Grove. This area of Kings Canyon has been called a rival of Yosemite Valley, featuring high granite cliffs in a lush valley, but without the crowds of Yosemite. You can take a short 0.3 mile hike just off the road to Roaring River Falls, or simply enjoy the great views from the road at Canyon View.
